Model 350.

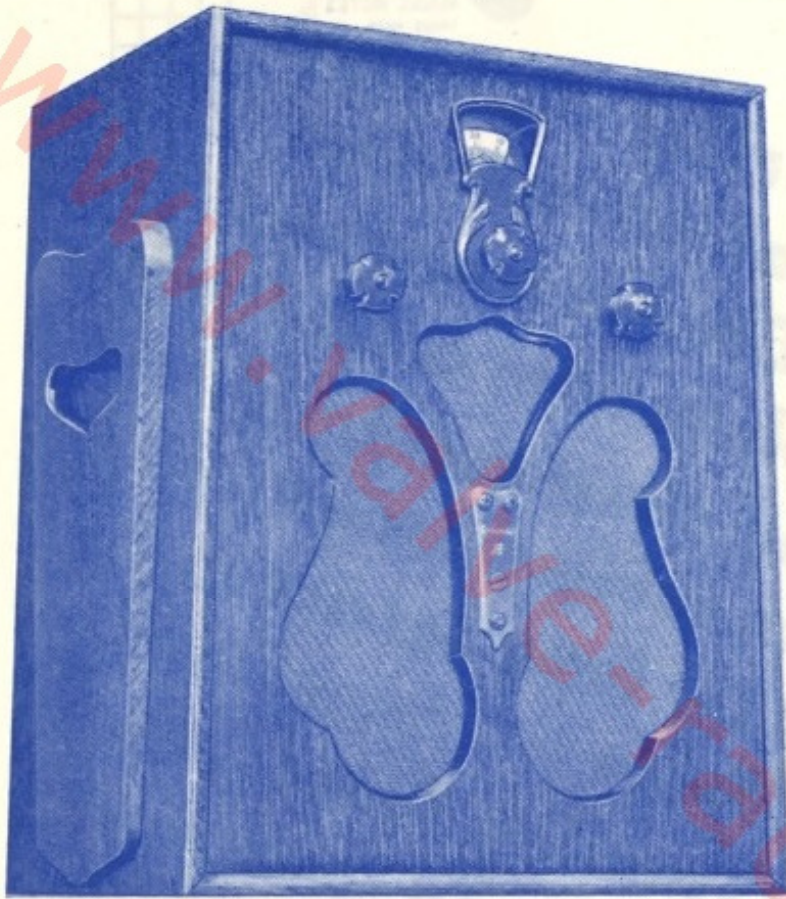
